

FAQs on PGDM Course for the Academic Year 2012-14

1. Is PGDM Course is Approved by AICTE ?

Yes. PGDM Programme is approved by All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE)

2. What is the duration of the course ?

Course is of Two Years. There are total four semesters.

3. How many Seats are available for each course ?

There are total 60 seats for this programme spread over three specializations Finance, Marketing & HR.

4. What is the Eligibility Criteria for these courses ?

Candidates must have passed a Three Years Bachelor's degree examination in any faculty of Mumbai University or an examination recognized by Mumbai University as equivalent thereto and must have 50% in final year exam and candidate must have appeared for Maharashtra CET – Feb 2012 or CAT / MAT / ATMA / XAT TEST of Nov 2011.

5. IS THERE ANY CUT-OFF ?

Cut-off score is decided on overall performance after GD / PI.

6. How can I apply for these course ?

MUMBAI CANDIDATES: Candidate can collect the Admission Form personally from the Institutes Admission Office by paying Rs. 1000/- in Cash.

OUTSIDE MUMBAI CANDIDATES : They can download the admission form from the website www.cimsr.org and send the duly filled application form along with DD of Rs. 1000/- in favour of 'Chanakya Institute of Management Studies and Research' payable at Mumbai. Admission KIT will be sent to the students on given address within 15 working days.

7. What is the timing of these courses?

Course lectures timing is 9.30 to 6.00pm.

8. How many Semesters are there ?

There are total 4 semesters in 2 years.

9. What are the timings to collect the form ? What is the form fee ?

Admission forms are available in Admission office of the institute from Monday to Friday from 10.00 am to 5.00 pm. Form fees is Rs. 1000/- which is non refundable. Form Fee is payable by CASH or Demand Draft only. Demand Draft should be in favour of 'Chanakya Institute of Management Studies and Research' payable at Mumbai of Rs. 1000/-

10. What is the last date of form submission ?

You can submit forms till 31st March 2012 till 5.00 pm. Kindly get in touch with the Institute at the earliest.

11. What is the admission procedure?

Valid MBA-CET / CAT / MAT / ATMA / XAT / CMAT score & GD / PI rounds. GD / PI rounds will be conducted at our Institute, selected centers PAN India or through video conferencing.

12. When is the Group Discussion and Personal Interview ?

These dates will be given to you when you in a week's time after you purchase the form. Those who apply through Demand Draft/ by post the GD-PI Dates will be inform to them by post.

13. Can we change the GD-PI Date ?

No. GD-PI Dates are not negotiable.

(If it is clashing with your **Final Year Graduation** Exam then, contact the Institute. No other personal reason is valid)

14. What is the dress code for Personal Interview?

Dress code is formal. No T-shirts allowed. For Girls sleeveless and skirts are not allowed.

15. What Original documents I required during personal interview ?

Following documents are required during Personal Interview.

1. Written Test Score Card (MH-CET and CAT)
2. SSC Marksheet
3. HSC Marksheet
4. Last Year Graduation Marksheet (if available)
5. Convocation Degree and Passing Certificate (if available)

6. Work Experience Certificate if any

7. Extra Curricular Activities if any (State level, National level etc)

16. When is the result of these courses ?

The result of PGDM is within 8 days from the last date of GD-PI which will be available on the institute notice board. It will be available on the website also.

17. What photocopies are required to submit with the form ?

Please send abovementioned photocopies with the form. All Original Documents will be verified during GD-PI Processes.

18. What is the fees of the courses ?

The fees for PGDM course is Rs.4,10,000/- (First year Rs.2,00,000/- + Rs.10,000/- refundable deposit & second year Rs.2,00,000/-) for two years. This fee includes Tuition Fees, LAPTOP, Books, Blazer, Study Material, Personality Development Workshop, Placement, etc. Since we are offering placements with good salaries, the cost of PGDM course fee can be recovered by students in full within 2 years after passing the course.

19. What is the course content of these course ?

Course content is available on the website in admission section.

20. Do you have accommodation available ?

Decent shared accommodation facility is available for both boys and girls at the cost of Rs.3,000/- to Rs.6,000/- per month. Cafeteria serving snacks as well as meals is available for students.

21. What is the placement Record of last batch ?

Highest Salary – Rs.5 Lakhs pa

Average Salary – Rs.2.75 Lakhs pa

Minimum Salary – Rs.2.25 Lakhs pa

23. Is the Institute located centrally in Mumbai ?

Yes, Institute is located centrally in the heart of Mumbai city, Juhu – Andheri. One can reach to the Institute at 7 minutes walk from Andheri Station. One can also reach to the Institute by buses, taxis and auto rickshaws.

24. Is PGDM equivalent to MBA and will PGDM passed student be able to take admission in Ph.D. ?

It is under process with AIU. Within six months it will get approved and PGDM passed students will be able to take admission into Ph.D.

All students get two months' summer internship after 2nd semester exams. Industry expert visiting faculties and guest lecturers give insight into current industry skills requirements. Local and national industry visits also club the academics to current industry requirements. Mumbai being the financial capital of country, pursuing PGDM in Mumbai helps students have an edge over other outstation students.

26. How are communication skills and corporate grooming taken care by the Institute?

Institute has special faculties for communication skills and corporate grooming. Apart from that Institute has lecture series by industry experts specially focused for corporate grooming, interview appearance, interview questionnaires and answers, etc.
